Duties & responsibilities

Duties will include, but are not limited to:

- Perform your job in a safe manner in line with RED Safety policies and procedures and take responsibility for your safe work behaviour.
- Keep a clean hygienic kitchen and eating area.
- To ensure nutritious home style meals are prepared for depot staff and visitors as required (10-15)
- Meal planning and stores planning.
- Prepare weekly grocery lists to maintain adequate supplies.
- Cater for meetings when required.
- Assist with the packing of meat for the kitchen.
- Clean and maintain supplies in laundry and abolition block.
- Report to management.
- Other Duties as required.

Requirements

- Previous experience in a similar role an advantage, you will need experience at managing a kitchen and providing meals to a flexible schedule, with an understanding of dietary nutrition and food hygiene. Have a high level of organisational skills to plan meals. Be self-motivated and reliable.
- Be prepared to work in a rural environment.
